Friday Schedule:

 - o Mobile tickets may be purchased in advance online through Ticketmaster at www.ticketmaster.com, or via the Ticketmaster mobile app. A per ticket fee of \$5.40 and a per transaction fee of \$5.40 will be charged by Ticketmaster in addition to the cost of the ticket. You must have, or set up, a Ticketmaster account to purchase tickets via Ticketmaster.

- **Mobile tickets** can be purchased on the day of the event at the Southeast Box Office of Lucas Oil Stadium for no addition fees. Tickets will be sent to your smartphone. Only credit cards or cash are accepted.
- **Advanced Tickets** can be purchased through the Band Boosters for no additional fee via cash payment. You must pay the ticket price (adult \$22, child \$18) and provide the following information:
 - **Name, number of tickets, smartphone number**

- Remember the procedure of letting Mr. K know if you are not riding bus home!
- Parents If you are not traveling with the band, and wish to get a good seat to watch the whole show - I recommend getting there before 9:00 a.m. (when doors open). Best seats? Go to aisle 240/239 or 241/240 and that will get you into the best area. Same #s for other levels (140, 340, etc.) Performance order of all classes is at www.issma.net or www.prideofpaoli.org. Hopefully you will have the opportunity to view the other band programs around the state along with the one we have. You will then understand why we work as hard as we do, and, why we have the expectations we do of our students. Our students, staff, and parents have done a tremendous job this year!!!
- Box moms, work out arrangements for someone to save you a seat so you can watch our show. This is really difficult, please don't expect any one person to save more than a single seat. You can understand how some people get upset, especially if they take the time to get there early themselves for a good seat.
